## | Negotiations to Resume 8/28 |

As has been discussed in previous updates, ASARCO management has slowed the pace of negotiations with one-sided contract language proposals aimed at eroding our rights at work.

When we resume negotiations, we are set to discuss successorship; child care, elderly care and dependent care; extended shifts; holidays; vacations; and leaves of absence.

ASARCO is demanding random drug testing. ASARCO wants to use the stringent Department of Transportation cutoff levels for the tests and has rejected proposals that would allow for **second-chance** agreements for positive tests.

To date, the Company's proposals include a "no fault" attendance policy, stripping our enhanced FMLA provision and eliminating local joint civil rights committees, along with radical and unnecessary changes to the grievance and arbitration procedure, day pay supervisors and leadperson positions.

In the meantime, your committee remains focused on reaching a fair agreement based on respect for workers' contributions to the Company's success and securing a better future for current and future generations of workers at ASARCO.
