Although our negotiating committee has not met with Asarco/Grupo Mexico management since our previous update, we continue to fight against the company's unreasonable demands. As discussed previously, Asarco/Grupo management wants to dramatically increase our health insurance costs. The company is also proposing to eliminate our insurance coverage when we retire!

Management continues to insist on other major economic and contract language changes that will only reduce our compensation and make our jobs less secure. We cannot allow Asarco/Grupo Mexico to take away what we have earned through years of struggle. We must continue to resist management's efforts and fight back together in solidarity.
