

BARGAINING UPDATE

The bargaining committee met with the company June **30-July 2**. Progress continues to be slow, but we remain **committed to resolving all current outstanding issues**. We are especially concerned with resolving two topics that were not included in the company's last, best, and final offer: **wage increases** and **retiree healthcare for all current employees**.

NO NEW DATES SCHEDULED

The union **offered to meet** with Asarco/Grupo Mexico on several dates in July, but the company claims its bargaining committee is **not available**. As ever, the union remains committed to meeting and **bargaining a fair and equitable contract**. The union is currently waiting for the company to offer more dates so that we can **continue working to reach a fair agreement**.

The union filed unfair labor practices at most ASARCO locations, alleging violations of the National Labor Relations Act. We want Asarco to come to the table and have a reasonable discussion, and we want to continue to work in safe, productive environments while we continue bargaining.

Asarco **also filed an unfair labor practice against the union**, alleging that we have been bargaining in bad faith. This charge is completely **unfounded and ridiculous**. **WE ARE DEDICATED TO NEGOTIATING A FAIR NEW CONTRACT.**
