

Dues Structure

As in other organizations (churches, clubs, etc.), dues are used to pay operating expenses.

USW dues are:

- ► 1.45% of total earnings, plus \$.02 per hour. OR
- ► A maximum of 2.8 times your average hourly rate, plus \$.02 per hour.

You will pay whichever is less.

- ▶ Minimum dues are \$5.00 per month.
- ► Initiation fee is waived for newly organized members.

Example of Weekly Dues

Hourly	Weekly Earning	1.45% of Total	\$.02 per	Total Weekly	Per
Rate	(40 hours)	Earning	hour	Dues	Hour
\$12.00	\$480.00	\$6.96	\$0.80	\$7.76	

Figure your dues:

 $\underbrace{X \ 40 \ hours = }_{(your \ hourly \ rate)} X \ 40 \ hours = \underbrace{X \ .0145 = }_{(dues)} + 0.80 = \underbrace{X \ .0145 = }_{(2 \ cents) = (Your \ weekly \ dues)}$

YOU WILL NOT BE ASKED TO PAY UNION DUES UNTIL YOU AND YOUR CO-WORKERS HAVE NEGOTIATED AND THE MAJORITY HAVE VOTED TO APPROVE YOUR FIRST CONTRACT.

- ► The USW dues structure can ONLY be changed at a democratically elected convention of USW members.
- ▶ 43% of all your membership dues come back to your local union to conduct your daily local union business.
- ▶ 57% of all your membership dues come back to you through the International and District by providing:
 - Technical and support services
 - Education and training
