A pre-registration form is enclosed for those who are not able to register online. Registration forms may be faxed to 412-562-2495 and the check mailed to headquarters at the address above with a copy of the completed form.

Participants will still be able to register once they arrive at the conference; however, the registration fee must be paid by Local Union check or cash. *We <u>will not</u> be able to accept credit cards at the conference venue.*
